



LLI-539 „Tour de Crafts“ project activities in June

This June activities of the project „Craftsmanship as Tourism Product without Borders (LLI-539 Tour de Crafts)“ under implementation of the Interreg V-A Latvia – Lithuania Cross Border Cooperation Programme 2014–2020 were intensively carried out.

In Latvia, Preili municipality, a three-day ceramic workshop for craftsmen took place, where ceramicists from both countries had a great opportunity to deepen their knowledge, meet new people, get ideas and inspiration, discuss the communion that connects them, and look for ways to create international works together.

On the first Saturday of the month – creators of Panevėžys district together with other project’s participants from Lithuania and Latvia participated in the Daugavpils city fair and presented their crafts, invited the fair guests to create a unique attribute and weave their own ribbon. After getting acquainted with the method of weaving the ribbon participants very willingly and enthusiastically joined educational activities and woven an element of Lithuanian national costume.

On 9th of June another project’s art fair took place in Anykščiai Art Incubator–Art Studio, which brought together participants from Lithuania and Latvia's partner countries. Participants shared their knowledge and experience, and the atmosphere of the event delighted everyone with good emotions. It was a beautiful day, full of various activities and warm communication!

All these project’s activities are implemented together with partners – Latgale Planning Region (Latvia), Preili and Balvi County Council (Latvia), Dobele Adult Education and Business Support Centre (Latvia) and Anykščiai Art Incubator–Art Studio – for the development of a new cross-border tourism product in craftsmanship to promote a sustainable use of traditional craft skills, preserving and presenting it as a common feature of the cultural and historical heritage of the Lithuanian-Latvian border area and a common tourism product that attracts tourist interest.
