## The third workshop meeting of „Easy Energy“ project in Panevėžys

On 29<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> of October, 2024, the meeting of the project “Easy Energy” Nr. #C051 took place in Panevėžys, Lithuania. The meeting was initiated by lead partner – Hanse Parliament. The reception was organised by Lithuanian project’s partners – the Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts, with support of the Panevėžys District Municipality. The meeting was attended by 11 project partners from 6 countries: Denmark (Vesthimmerlands Municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga planning region), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Panevėžys District Municipality), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences) and Germany (ZEBAU – Centre for Energy, Building, Architecture and the Environment and Hanse Parliament).

During the meeting, Jan Gerbitz from ZEBAU, presented to the project partners that in total 107 possible “Easy Energy” solutions have been gathered and summarized from all partners. While meeting was ongoing all of the partners tried to systematise and to choose the most appropriate “Easy Energy” solutions, which will be tested in each participating country, both in public buildings and in small businesses premises in the next phase of the project. The further implementation of the project activities and the administrative matters were discussed during the meeting in Panevėžys.

During the meeting in Panevėžys project partners visited two business enterprises: brewery LTD “Kalnapilis-Taurus grupė” and art glass studio LTD “Glasremis”, where they learned about innovative energy-saving and sustainability solutions implemented in the businesses.

The next online meeting with project partners is planned to be in January of 2025 and also in the same year in April, partners are planning to meet for the next workshop in Finland.
