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The online meeting of "Easy Energy" project partners

On 21st of January, an online meeting of the "Easy Energy" project partners took place on the "Zoom" platform. The meeting was initiated by the main partner of the project - Hanse Parlament. Representatives of 12 project partners from 7 countries participated in the remote meeting: Denmark (Vesthimmerlands municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Regional Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga Planning Region), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts Chamber and Panevėžys District Municipality), Poland (Pomeranian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Otulina Association), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences) and Germany (ZEBAU - Energy, Construction, Architecture and Environment Center and Hanse Parlament).

During the meeting was reviewed how the proposals for simple, inexpensive, easy and quick to implement energy saving solutions in the areas of building insulation, heating, ventilation systems and electricity saving, which were submitted by all project partners, are being systematized and are currently being systematized by the main project partner from Germany - the Hanse Parlament and the Energy, Architecture and Environmental Protection Center ZEBAU. The selected solutions will be tested in the near future in public buildings and (or) small businesses selected by the project partners. The implementation of other project activities and administrative nuances of the project were also discussed during the meeting.

The next online meeting is scheduled to be organized in March, 2025. A face-to-face meeting of the project partners is planned April 9–10 in the city of Pori, Finland.
