Flax museum repair works

As part of the digital exhibition creation process, Panevėžys District Municipality is also undertaking repair works at the Flax Museum to house the exhibitions of the project **LL-00100 „Digital Craft Tourism“** (D-tour) in warm rooms. This will allow visitors to visit all year round, not just during the warm season, as has been the case so far.

After the project is implemented, visitors will be invited to visit the following digital craft exhibitions in Lithuania and Latvia:

- traditional Aukštaitija region ribbon weaving at the Flax Museum and traditional folk music instruments at Upytė Traditional Crafts Center barn, Panevėžys district;
- ceramics – at Anykščiai Art Incubator–Art Studio;
- „The Universe of Latgale Traditional Crafts“ – in Daugavpils;
- woodworking and wooden architecture typical of Kraslava – in Kraslava.
