The fifth workshop meeting of „Easy Energy“ project

On October 15th - 17th of this year a partner meeting of the project “Easy Energy” Nr. #C051 took place in Zakopane, Poland. It was initiated by the main project partner - Hanse Parliament, while the participant reception was organized by Polish partners, the representatives of the Pomeranian Chamber of Crafts. 12 project partners from 6 countries participated in the meeting: Denmark (Vesthimmerlands Municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga planning region), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Panevėžys District Municipality), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences), Germany (ZEBAU – Centre for Energy, Building, Architecture and the Environment and Hanse Parliament) and Poland (Pomeranian Chamber of Crafts). Panevėžys district municipality was represented by members of the project work group - the Head of the Construction and Infrastructure Department Rimantas Samkus and Senior specialist of the same department Domas Jankevičius.

The first day of the meeting was focused on the discussion of the piloting of simple, cheap and easily applicable solutions for saving energy in the buildings selected by the project partners. Time was also spent by presenting dissemination progress of the project by each partners' institutions.

The next two days were dedicated to the energy consultant training. The energy consultants had an opportunity to improve their skills in the energy sector. During the discussions, workshops and expert presentations participants improved their technical knowledge and learned what personal qualities are beneficial while working on this job.

The project coordinator Sebastian Hentsch from the Interreg Baltic Sea Region program also participated in the events and offered helpful feedback for improving the public visibility and the effectiveness of results of the project.

The next workshop of all project partners is being planned to take place in the end of February or beginning of March of 2026 in Estonia.

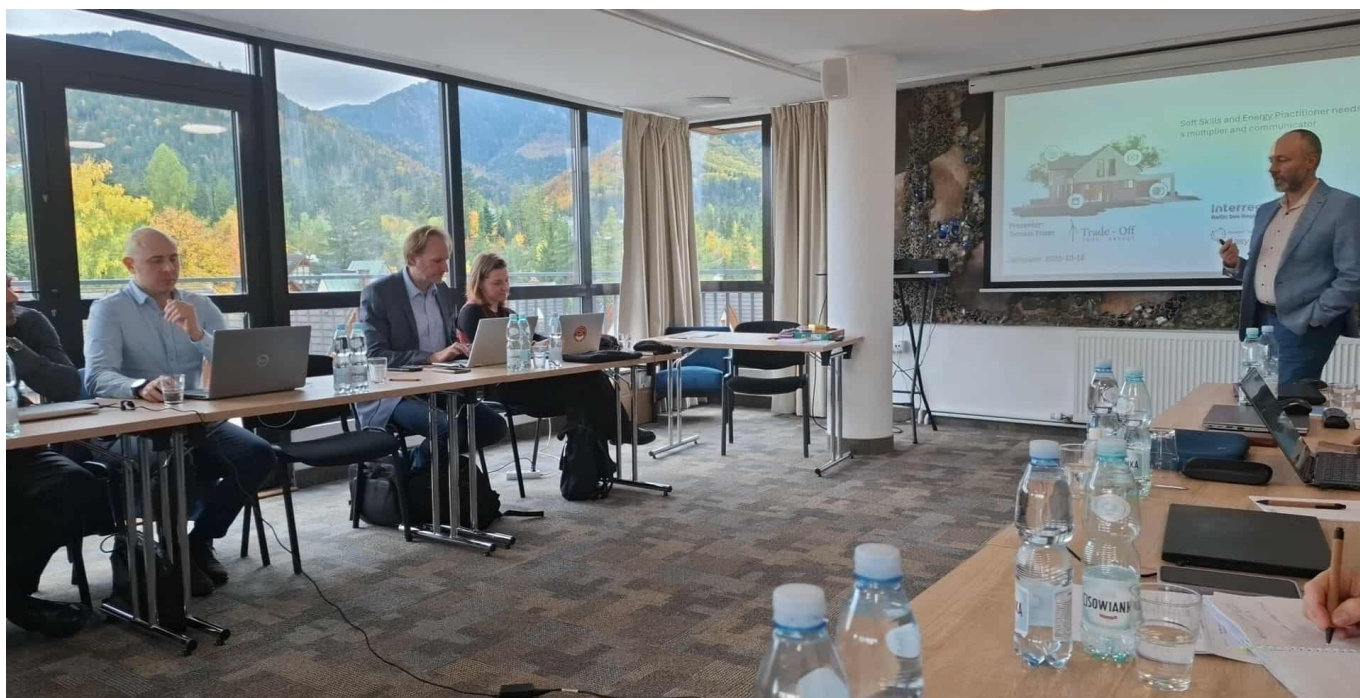
