Remote meeting of the partners of the “Easy Energy” project

On December 15, 2025, a remote meeting of the Easy Energy project partners took place on the Zoom platform. The meeting was initiated by the main project partner, the Hanseatic Parliament. The remote meeting was attended by representatives of 12 project partners from 7 countries: Denmark (Vesthimmerlands Municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Regional Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga Planning Region), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Panevėžys District Municipality), Poland (Pomeranian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Otulina Association), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences) and Germany (ZEBAU – Centre for Energy, Construction, Architecture and Environment and Hanseatic Parliament).

During the meeting, the project partners shared their experiences on how each of them is doing in implementing the planned energy saving measures, and the deadlines for the project implementation reports were presented. During the remote meeting, the details of the next meeting in Tallinn, Estonia, were discussed. The meeting also reviewed the implementation of further project activities and administrative aspects of the project.

The next working meeting of the project partners is planned for March 11-12, 2026, in Tallinn, Estonia.
