Online meeting of the partners of the “Easy Energy” project

On January 14, 2026, a remote meeting of the Easy Energy project partners took place on the Zoom platform. The meeting was initiated by the main project partner, the Hanse Parliament. The remote meeting was attended by representatives of 12 project partners from 7 countries: Denmark (Vesthimmerlands Municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Regional Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga Planning Region), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Panevėžys District Municipality), Poland (Pomeranian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Otulina Association), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences) and Germany (ZEBAU – Centre for Energy, Construction, Architecture and Environment and Hanse Parliament).

During the meeting, the implementation of project activities and reporting deadlines were reviewed, and details of the meeting to be held in Tallinn, Estonia, on March 11-12, 2026, were discussed.
