Project results discussion event

On 26 of February, 2026 a meeting of the Steering Committee of Interreg VI-A Latvia-Lithuania Programme 2021–2027 project LL-00100 „**Digital Craft Tourism**” (D-tour) took place at Panevėžys district municipality. The meeting was organised by the project partner – Panevėžys district municipality administration. During the meeting, all project partners, pleased with two years of intensive joint work, presented the project activities implemented and the results achieved. The lead project partner provided a detailed presentation of the guidelines for completing and submitting the fourth project report.

The project implementation sites were also visited – at the Flax Museum in Stultiškiai Windmill, the digital exhibition „Linen Tale” presenting weaving of traditional Aukštaitija region ribbons was viewed in an experiential way, and the possibilities of the digital exhibition „Tradition that sounds” on traditional folk music instruments of Panevėžys region were tested at Upytė traditional crafts centre. New project ideas and networking opportunities were discussed together with the project partners.

The project contributes to the preservation and promotion of traditional crafts, strengthens cross-border cultural cooperation between Latvia and Lithuania, and presents the living heritage of these regions through modern digital tools.
