The fifth workshop meeting of „Easy Energy“ project

The sixth meeting of the “Easy Energy” project No. # C051, initiated by the lead partner, the Hanse Parliament, and hosted by the Estonian partners—representatives of the Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Industry. The meeting was attended by representatives of 12 project partners from 7 countries: Denmark (Vesthimmerland Municipality), Estonia (Estonian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Tartu Regional Energy Agency), Latvia (Latvian Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Riga Planning Region), Poland (Pomeranian Chamber of Crafts), Lithuania (Panevėžys Chamber of Commerce and Crafts and Panevėžys District Municipality), Finland (Satakunta University of Applied Sciences), and Germany (ZEBAU – Center for Energy, Construction, Architecture, and Environment, and the Hanseatic Parliament). The Panevėžys District Municipality was represented by members of the project working group: Ingrida Goštautienė, Senior Specialist of the Investment and Foreign Relations Department; Rimantas Samkus, Head of the Construction and Infrastructure Department and Domas Jankevičius, Senior Specialist.

During the working meeting, the partners evaluated the energy-saving solutions selected during the project’s implementation, discussed aspects of disseminating the project’s results, and shared information on next steps. The meeting also covered the use of the project budget and other administrative details of the project.

On the second day of the meeting, participants visited the Kalev SPA wellness complex in Tallinn, where they were introduced to various heating, ventilation, electricity, water used for treatments, and other energy-saving solutions that ensure greater energy efficiency in buildings.

The next working meeting of all project partners is scheduled to take place on September 28–29, 2026, in Latvia.
